### COLLECTIVE IMPACT


- A group working towards the same outcome

## PREMISE OF COLLECTIVE IMPACT

- We are facing complex, systemic issues where no ready formula exists – the easy work has been done
- No single program, organisation or institution can bring about large-scale community change alone
- More money, new programs or working harder will not fundamentally change things
- Transformation happens when we work together and align efforts.

## WHAT IS COLLECTIVE IMPACT?

We act and think differently to the past, because if we keep doing what we are doing nothing will change. It is an emerging field, without a ready roadmap.

- Everyone who cares is going in the same direction
- The community is involved in driving change
- Rigour and discipline are embedded into the work through measurement for data-driven decision making
- Community assets, resources, talents and money are leveraged to build long term self-sustainability.

## THE CASE FOR CATALYTIC PHILANTHROPY


ten20 commits to funding real, lasting, systemic change and rejects funding solutions that perpetuate the current cycle.
